Obtaining Consent Checklist

Has the nature of the procedure been explained to the patient in detail?
Has the patient been provided with written material in relation to the procedure to be undertaken, if appropriate?
Has there been a cost disclosure about likely costs and any reason that the costs may differ?
Has the risks and benefits, as normally understood by dentists, been explained to the patient?
Are there any particular risks in relation to this procedure that are pertinent to this patient that they would not necessarily advert to?
Has the patient been given an opportunity to ask questions about the procedure?
Has the patient been given an opportunity to ask questions about the costs?
Has the patient had explained to them the adverse outcomes that can arise in terms of the procedure for their teeth, their oral health and their general health?
Have the consequences of taking no action at all been explained to the patient?
Have alternative options been explained to the patient for the treatment of the condition?
Has a referral been considered and offered to the patient in relation to the treatment?
Has the patient been reassured that if they change their mind or have any questions, they are free to contact the practice and speak to the practitioner or to make an appointment for an additional consultation?
Has a treatment plan been provided to the patient?
Has the treatment plan been explained to the patient?
Do the clinical notes reflect the above ?
